ELA:

Spelling: dress, spell, class, full, add, neck, stuck, kick, rock, black, trick, doll, off, across, pocket

Vocabulary: blooming-having flowers, shovels-garden tools used for lifting soil, scent- a smell, tough-hard, thick on the outside, wrinkled-crumpled or folded in a messy way, plain-simple, not fancy, muscles-parts of the body used to help you lift or move things, nodded-move the head up and down

Phonics: Double Consonants and ck words (fluff, dress, spill, quack) **Grammar:** Proper Nouns: Common Nouns name specific people, places, or Things. (teacher- *Mrs. Hartke is a proper noun*. Proper nouns always begin with a capital letter. Teacher is a common noun.

High Frequency Words: air, car, cried, funny, he, pictures, pretty, told, try, window

Math:

Review- addition and subtraction up to twenty. Review tens and ones with two digit numbers, expanded form, number values, greater than, less than, and equal too. **Review estimating and rounding to the nearest 10**. (When rounding if the number in the ones column is 1, 2, 3, 4- round down. If the number in the ones column is 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9- round up. Example- 43 rounds down to 40. 46 rounds up to 50).

New-Odd and Even Numbers, counting by 1's, 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's, and 10's, number patterns and ordinal numbers (1st-first, 2nd-second, 3rd-third, etc.)

Religion:

Students will continue to further their understanding of forgiveness. We will work on how to reconcile when we do something hurtful or we are hurt from someone else. We will work on making good choices.
