Math

Please practice skip counting by two's, five's, and ten's. Once your child can do that count by three's and four's using the number chart attached. Review greater than, less than, and equal too. Review estimating real life objects (example: how many pieces of Halloween candy do you have? 100 pieces or 30 pieces). Review what comes after a number or before a number (example: what comes before 38? Answer-37). Review ordering numbers from greatest to least and least to greatest (example: order these numbers from greatest to least. 34, 14, 43, Answer: 43, 34, 14). Review rounding to the nearest ten. Rule- if the number ends in a 1, 2, 3, 4- round down, if the number ends in 5, 6, 7, 8, 9- round up (example 38 rounds to 40 and 24 rounds to 20). Review ordinal numbers to thirty-first (31st). Keep drilling addition and subtraction!!!!
