Spelling- wet, job, hug, rest, spot, mud, left, help, plum, nut, net, hot, get, not, lunch and spend

Review addition and subtraction fact through twenty. Your child should be able to do this without counting on fingers. We are reviewing strategies such as *counting up* and *down* using the number line, *doubles, doubles plus* and minus one, as well as the *make ten* strategies.
