ELA

Spelling- cannot, pancake, maybe, baseball, playground, someone, myself, classroom, sunshine, outside, upon, nothing, into, inside, nobody, everywhere

High Frequency Words- after, book, care, ever, live, new, off, over, small thought

Vocabulary- *obeys*-does something someone says; *safety*-ways to keep from getting hurt; *attention*-focus, notice; *buddy*-friend or partner; *station*-workplace, office, space, base; *speech*-a talk that you give to a group of people; *shocked*-surprised, upset; *enormous*-really big or huge

Grammar- abbreviations

Phonics- Compound words with the schwa vowel sound.

Math

Religion- We will review the Sacrament of Reconciliation. *Words to know;* **reconciliation-** Making up again after a friendship is broken-in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we are reconciled with God, the Church and others, **confession**-the act of telling our sins to a priest, **penance**-prayers or good deeds that make up for our sins, **contrition**-the sadness we feel when we have sinned, **absolution**-forgiveness of God. Remember- a sin is when we *choose* to turn away from God, an *accident*, a *mistake*, or a *temptation* is not a sin.
