1. **Sacrament** *is a way that the Church meets Jesus*

2. **Baptism**-the first Sacrament which we become members of the Church. Baptism frees us from original sin and gives us new life in Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.
3. **Confirmation**-the Sacrament that completes the grace we receive at Baptism
4. **Original sin**-The result of the sin of Adam and Eve.
5. **faith**- a gift of God. Faith helps us believe in God and live as God wants us to live.
6. **bishop**- leaders of the Church. **priest**- They guide the Church and lead it in the celebration of the Sacraments.
7. **Trinity**-The mystery of one God in three Persons; the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
8. **disciple**- followers of Jesus
